By car:

satnav:

NP18 1LS [this will take you to the instruction marked *** below].

from the East:

- M4 to junction 25. Head north on B4596 to Caerleon.
- Follow your nose, winding through the village to far end to a mini roundabout.
- Head straight on, [heading North, over the speed bumps] for just under 3 miles. {If you go too far, you'll pass / turn round at Cwrt Bledwyn hotel on left}
- At the first 'serious' left turn, signed **Llandegvedd Village** with a sign on the right hand side of the road, head down this twisty turny uppy-downy side road [Tre-herbert Road] for 0.9 mile. After 0.6 mile pass 'Wellington Cottage' on the left. Carry on.
- *** Most satnavs think you've arrived as you pass some semi-detached houses on the right. Carry on over the blind summit.
- Follow the road round to the right. After about 150 yards look out for the track on the left. This leads to Llansôr Mill. [If you go too far you'll pass the posh iron-gated entrance to Llansôr Manor on the right].
- Go down the bumpy track, cross the bridge, and park on the grass by the old lawn roller.
- Our cottage is perched half way up the hill. Sound your horn if we're expecting you, and we'll come down to meet you. Sound your horn if we're not expecting you, and we'll still come down to meet you.

from the West:

- J25 cannot be accessed heading East. Easiest if you go East to Junction 24, do a full 180 turn back to J25 heading west, and follow instructions above.

from the North:

- Leave the M5 at junction 8 on the M50. This mutates into the A40 near Ross.
- Carry on; this mutates into the A449, signed for Newport and Cardiff.
- Turn off on the A472 marked for Usk. [if you miss this turn you'll have to go all the way down to the M4 at J24; head West one junction and follow instructions above]
- Go through the town and over the bridge at the far end; immediately turn sharp left [BP garage on right].
- Follow this road for about 4 miles, through the village of Llangibby [if satnav says turn right here ignore it]
- Pass the 'Best Western' Cwrt Bledwyn hotel on right.
- At the first right turn after the hotel, signed **Llandegvedd Village** with a sign on the left hand side of the road, head down this twisty turny uppy-downy side road [Tre-herbert Road] for 0.9 mile. After 0.6 mile pass 'Wellington Cottage' on the left. Carry on.
- *** Most satnavs think you've arrived as you pass some semi-detached houses on the right. Carry on over the blind summit.
- Follow the road round to the right. After about 150 yards look out for the track on the left. This leads to Llansôr Mill. [If you go too far you'll pass the posh iron-gated entrance to Llansôr Manor on the right].
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By train:

- nearest station [4 miles] is Cwmbran – good if travelling from the North, via Crewe.
- second nearest is Newport [8 miles] – good if travelling from the East.
